




### P & PB Production and Consumption






#### Weight — Production of Each Grade VS Total (2018)






#### Weight — Consumption of Each Grade VS Total (2018)

# Outlook





- Capita consumption level of paper and paperboard is an important sign to measure a country's economy and civilization. The consumption of paper is directly and indirectly affected by various fields of the whole society. At present, the developed countries in the world have a developed paper industries, which is listed as one of the pillar industries.
- Capita consumption is an important indicator to measure a country's comprehensive economic strength. In 2018, the capita consumption of paper and paperboard in the world is about 57 kg / a, while that in China is 78 kg / a.
- Although China's capita consumption is higher than the world average level, but it is lower than the capita consumption of 150-300 kg / year in developed countries, so there is still a huge space for development.
